The ministries of Argentina, which form the cabinet, currently consist of eight ministries under a ministerial chief of staff. The ministers are appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the president. The current organization derives from the constitutional revision of 1994.

Cabinet includes the official name of the executive branch's high-ranking body and the method of member selection. Elections/appointments includes the process for accession to office, date of the ...

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As of the latest version of the Law on Ministries, these are the existing secretariats of the presidency counting with ministerial rank in the Argentine government.
