A pigtail electrical wire connector is a simple DIY project, whether you need to extend a short wire or connect neutral, hot, and ground wires to a circuit.

Per NEC (National Electrical Code) standards, you can use no more than one wire per screw. Never connect more than one wire under a single screw terminal as it could cause arching ...

Cut three separate pigtail wires--one black (hot), one white (neutral), and one bare or green (ground)--to a length of six to eight inches. This length provides enough slack to comfortably ...
