

# How to open the power port on a fiber optic cable

Grasp the connector body (not the cable!) of the fiber optic or copper cable. Depress the latch on the connector (for LC, SC types) and pull the connector straight out smoothly.

Align the module with the device's SFP port, ensuring TX/RX labels match the cable's direction. Gently push the module until it clicks into place (a latch will secure it).

Note: If the latch is blocked and you cannot open it with your index finger, use a small, one-way screwdriver or other slender tools to open the latch. Grasp the module with your thumb and ...

Connect the fiber optic cable: Plug one end of the fiber cable into the wall outlet and the other into the ONT's designated port. Power on the ONT: Use the provided power adapter....

The fiber optic cable is very sensitive to mechanical torsion and should never be bent too tight. Loose coils are fine. If the fiber patch cord is broken, you can replace it with a new cord.

Before removing the transceiver, make sure that you open the ejector lever completely until you hear it click. This precaution prevents damage to the transceiver. Grasp the transceiver ejector lever and ...
