4.04 The depth at which fiber optic cable can be buried will vary with local conditions according to freeze lines (depth to which the ground freezes in the winter).

The National Electrical Code Article 830.47 specifies 18 inches as the minimum depth for direct burial of fiber optic cables classified as network-powered broadband communication systems.

Individual company practices for placing fiber optic cable should supersede any conflicting instructions in this document when they do not exceed the cable's optical and mechanical performance specifications.

A minimum depth of 4.5 feet below the base of rail (BBR) will be maintained except that a minimum of 5 feet BBR will be maintained for fiber optic cable wirelines.

The short answer, based on general industry standards and the National Electrical Code (NEC), is that fiber optic cable is typically buried between 24 inches (60 cm) and 30 inches (76 cm) deep. However, ...
