**Aerial Suspension:** A type of fiber optic cable known as "aerial suspension" uses high-tension wires stretched between the two ends of the transmission line. These wires are used to facilitate cable ...

An aerial fiber optic cable is an insulated cable usually containing optical fibers required for a telecommunication line, which is suspended between utility poles.

Aerial optical cable is suspended in the air from poles and/or support structures. Most often it is supported between poles by being lashed to a wire rope messenger strand with a small gauge wire.
